TV and Podcast













In Nairobi, Vidar has had multiple opportunities to teach and talk about the Good News on TV broadcastings and podcasts. To us, it is important to get the message out to as many people as possible, as we know it will produce a change in people's lives. So far, we have received many good feedbacks from people listening to these broadcasts.

Conferences

In 2022, we hosted conferences both in Kisumu and Nairobi. These are geared toward ministering to believers with the teaching of the Word of God and the demonstration of the Holy Spirit. We also use this opportunity to recruit new students for our school.











Farming

One of the results we are looking for, is to see our graduates become producers in their own society. We often encourage the pastors to start with what they have in order to increase their income by creating value in their areas. Many people have access to farm land, but often this land is never developed and just sits there without producing anything. After encouraging our students, many graduates learn new farming techniques and start farming on their family property. Pastor Meni has recently developed water pans and irrigation in a rural area that is often plagued with periods of drought. However, during the rainy season, the rivers overflow and water is plentiful. By preserving this water, he is now able to produce watermelons even when there is no rain.

Rhema Bible Training College Kenya

Our Bible School has multiple locations in order to train pastors and leaders from various parts of the country. As much as we give them knowledge of God's Word, it is also a training ground with many practical applications. The students get to clean the classroom and offices on a rotating schedule, they do a missions outreach in second year where they plan, execute, and fundraise for the trip, and they get to volunteer for our conferences and other events. By the time they have finished, they are a changed person!













New National Coordinator

We welcomed Mary Wambui to our team as our new Rhema Kenya National Coordinator. We are excited for this new position as she works on bringing unity across the various campuses and takes over a lot of the responsibilities that we have previously held.

Alumni

We were able to host several alumni fellowships throughout the country in 2022. It was a refreshing time for the graduates to come together and listen to each other's testimonies and to network with various classes that have gone through the school.











Graduation

The highlight of the students' year is the graduation in November. Three campuses, Nairobi, Mombasa, and Kisumu, come together for this occasion. It marks the beginning of a new season, yet the learning will never be done. We celebrate together with the students and their families.









Congo

Our Congo mission has been ongoing for a couple of years, and we have spent this time networking with local pastors and identifying the needs on the ground. We finished our preliminary conferences in 2022, and started the first official minister's training. We will be doing 4 modules of intensive training at each place we go. The first set of modules started in Goma, but there is also high demand for us to start the same course in Butembo. The students are eager and the reports we hear shows that they are understanding the message of freedom! We are also broadcasting teachings on radio several times a week, and the audience reach is more than 3 million people. This has been very effective as radio is widely used in the society, and you can commonly find a group of 20 men surrounding a radio to listen to important teaching.







New Vehicle

Thanks to our partners, we were able to purchase another vehicle that is more fit for the long drive from Kenya to Congo. It is a much bigger and more comfortable vehicle that is frequently used for Safaris in Africa. This vehicle is also equipped with the necessary 4 WD and 2 diesel tanks for the long drives. We thank God for this blessing!









Judiciary

In 2022, we were approached by some of the high courts in Kenya to come and pray and preach at their functions. It was an honor to stand before some of the most influential judges in the country and speak the truth of God's Word and to encourage the people working in the judiciary system. We are thankful for this opportunity to be a blessing in Kenya.




Results and Partnership
